






CITY COUNCIL MEETING RECAP (CONT.)

The City Council discussed a feasibility study for a boat launch and dry stack facility at the Marina. The study will explore various structures, projected capital costs, operating costs, and revenue potential. Additionally, it will examine a possible multipurpose building to serve different public and private functions. A dry stack for boat storage and a new boat launch present an opportunity to generate much-needed revenue that could help cover the future capital needs at the Marina. We will keep the Council and the public informed as we investigate this project's feasibility.

So, just when I think no one reads these recipes...I've gotten some feedback about my lack of recipes the last couple of weeks. So...recipe is back! This is a chicken noodle soup with a twist that I recently made for my family, and it was a big hit. I found it on a blog I love to follow—LideyLikes. She is a chef, New York Times food writer, and was mentored by Ina Garten (my personal hero). Her cookbook- Cooking in Real Life- is excellent. Enjoy!

Avgolemono-ish Chicken Noodle Soup

Servings: 8 to 10





KATHERINE'S FUN STUFF (CONT.)

Ingredients

- 1 rotisserie chicken
- 3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil, plus more for drizzling
- Kosher salt and freshly groundblack pepper
- 1½ cups small-diced carrots (about 3 medium carrots)
- 1½ cups small-diced celery (about 3 large celery ribs)
- 1 large yellow onion, chopped
- 12 cups (3 quarts) low-sodium chicken broth
- 1 cup ditalini, acini di pepe, or pearl couscous
- 1 (15-ounce) can chickpeas, rinsed and drained
- 3 large egg yolks
- 1/3 cup freshly squeezed lemon juice (2 lemons)
- 3 cups fresh baby spinach
- 1/4 cup minced fresh dill or parsley, plus more for serving

Instructions

- 1. Take apart and shred the rotisserie chicken.
- 2.In a large pot, heat the olive oil over medium heat. Add the carrots, celery, and onion and cook, stirring occasionally, until the onion is translucent, and the vegetables are beginning to soften, 8 to 10 minutes.
- 3.Add the broth, 1 tablespoon salt, and 1 teaspoon pepper and bring to a boil over mediumhigh heat. Reduce the heat and cook at a vigorous simmer until the broth has reduced slightly and the vegetables are tender, about 10 minutes.
- 4. Add the pasta and chickpeas and cook, stirring occasionally, until the pasta is al dente. Reduce the heat to low, add the chicken and cook until just heated through. Set the soup aside off the heat.
- 5. In a medium bowl, whisk together the egg yolks and lemon juice. Whisking constantly, slowly pour a ladleful of hot broth into the egg mixture. Repeat several more times until the mixture is warm to the touch. Stirring constantly, gradually pour the egg mixture into the soup.
- 6.Add the spinach and dill and stir until the spinach wilts. Taste for seasonings, then serve hot, garnishing each serving with extra dill and a few grinds of black pepper.
