STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS

At last night's study session, the City Council discussed a process to develop a city strategic plan.

A strategic plan is a multi-year roadmap that guides the city's decisions and spending priorities. Unlike a city comprehensive plan, which focuses specifically on land-use decisions, a strategic plan lays out the city's overall goals, priorities and actions. Community input is an important part of the strategic planning process, and I have heard from the community a strong desire to have more opportunities to participate and share your priorities with the City. Due to the City's financial challenges, we will also need to make sure plans for revenue growth and financial sustainability are drivers for the overall Strategic Planning effort. More to

CITY OF DES MOINES RECEIVES DISTINGUISHED **BUDGET PRESENTATION AWARD**

The City of Des Moines has received the Government Finance Officers Association's (GFOA) Distinguished Budget Presentation Award. This prestigious award recognizes the City's commitment to the highest principles of governmental budgeting. To earn the award, Des Moines met national guidelines for budget presentation, excelling in four key areas: policy document, financial plan, operations guide, and communications tool. The City's budget documents were rated "proficient" in all categories and mandatory criteria. This achievement places Des Moines among over 1,700 participants in the GFOA Budget Awards Program.

For those of you that love to read a government budget and have seen our budget book, we know we can make it even better in the future. Finance staff are already at work for next year's budget—our goal is for the document to be clear, easy to understand and lay person friendly. More improvements to come!

KING COUNTY WATER TAXI **'SALLY FOX' TESTS POTENTIAL DES MOINES ROUTE**

King County Metro's Marine Division conducted a "fit-up trip" aboard the Water Taxi Sally Fox on Saturday, March 1, 2025, to evaluate the vessel's systems, crew operations, and docking procedures for potential future service to the Des Moines Marina.

The test run showcased the vessel's journey from Pier 50 in downtown Seattle to the Des Moines Marina on a foggy morning, providing a preview of what expanded passenger ferry service could offer South King County.

This initiative is a collaborative effort between King County and the local community to explore the feasibility of a new commuter ferry service. While no definitive timeline has been set for service to Des Moines, the test trip marks a significant step toward a more connected future for the region.
