Come meet and chat with our new City Manager, Katherine Caffrey! You'll have the time and space to get to know her, ask questions and share your vision for Des Moines.

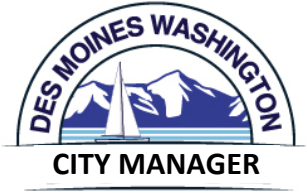

South King Housing and Homelessness Partners (SKHHP) Affordable Housing Tour

On September 20, 2024, SKHHP facilitated a tour of affordable housing sites in South King County. SKHHP, of which Des Moines is one of 9 South King County cities to comprise the group, is actively involved in affordable housing project work, renovations and rehabilitation. Victorian Place II is located in Des Moines, and received grant funding from SKHHP for \$777,306 to support the rehabilitation of the two buildings including: landscape improvements, staircase repairs, installation of new railings, seal coating the parking lot, upgrading external lighting, recoating tenant decks, installation of new siding, replacing gutters and downspouts, replacing windows, replacing sliding glass doors, replacing unit entry doors, and replacing baseboard heating with energy-efficient heating systems. Rehabilitation and Renovation is underway!
