- June 22, 2023, City Council directed City Manager to explore remedies for business relief.
- City Manager focused on immediate liquidity needs and support for employee wage earners.

6/24/23


Businesses closed for up to 7days. Business closure coincided with Father's Day and Juneteenth



#### Outcomes:

- The focus of this grant program was to enhance liquidity and support wage earners.
- ~ 35 Applications approved for award.
- Most applicants received payment within two weeks of submittal.
- ~ In total, \$175,000 allocated to support our local business and employees.
