- 1. The 03.28.2024 Municipal Facilities Minutes were approved as submitted.
- Acting Public Works Director Tommy Owen reviewed Attachment #2. KPFF/PLACE, the design team
 working on this project provided renderings at the 60% design stage. Stormwater features will be
 integrated into the plans. Director Owen stated undergrounding the utilities in this area is
 challenging, staff are actively engaging with PSE.
- 3. Khai Le, Acting City Engineer summarized the history and current status of the Redondo Fishing Pier/Restroom Replacement Project. It is recommended that Council reject the one bid received for the project as it was more than double the estimated cost. Staff are working with the consultants to look for alternatives in order to move the project forward with the current budget. One possible solution is to split the project into two phases, the restroom replacement and the pier replacement. It is hoped the restroom project could be completed by the end of 2024. The committee discussion included:
 - Lighting and paid parking infrastructure
 - Review of the high bid for understanding
 - Potential follow up to Pier Replacement plan holders to discover why bids weren't submitted
