DMMC MISSION STATEMENT

Des Moines Municipal Court is dedicated to the fair, impartial, and timely administration of justice, providing the community it serves with a safe and accessible environment that is respectful to all. The business of the Court shall be conducted with integrity, competence, and a commitment to excellence, in order to promote public trust and confidence in our system of justice.

CORE SERVICES

- File, process, & adjudicate the following:
 - Criminal Cases: misdemeanors & gross misdemeanor charges
 - Traffic Infractions
 - Photo Enforcement Citations
 - Parking Tickets
 - Non-Traffic Civil Infractions: abatement/nuisance cases, animal code violations
 - Vehicle Impounds
- Post-conviction supervision & monitoring of sentencing conditions in criminal cases

COURT PROGRAMS

- <u>Support Services (Probation)</u>: random drug testing program; cognitive behavioral programming such as Domestic Violence Moral Reconation Therapy (DVMRT); ongoing case management to monitor compliance with conditions of sentence
- <u>DUI Court</u>: therapeutic court for high risk/high needs DUI offenders provides intensive supervision, increased accountability, and wrap-around services with treatment, cognitive behavioral programs, relicensing, budgeting, and more. Since 2018, served 32 participants with 12 graduates.

COURT PROGRAMS (CONTINUED)

- <u>Pretrial & Post-Conviction Monitoring</u>: GPS, electronic home detention, alcohol monitoring (EHM Washington); ordered as condition of pretrial release, sanction for non-compliance, and/or alternative to confinement
- Peer Navigator Program: in partnership with Federal Way Municipal Court and Peer Connections, peer navigators work with justice-involved individuals to connect them with housing, treatment, employment, health care, and basic needs resources.
- <u>Unified Payment Program (UPP)</u>: multi-jurisdictional payment option for legal financial obligations
- King County Interjurisdictional Warrant Program



NUMBER OF CASES FILED 2022-2024




NUMBER OF HEARINGS HELD 2022-2024






- Staffing





2024 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Completion of Sound Transit Federal Way Link Extension (FWLE) improvements (Pacific Ridge, College Way)
- Coordinated with partners to install speed cameras in Redondo
- Completed most extensive pavement overlay project ever by the City
- Coordinated with WSDOT SR 509 team to reconstruct 216th Street bridge over I-5 and improve Barnes Creek Trail within historic SR 509 right-of-way
- Reviewed 206 development permits and 228 Right-of-Way Permits
- Reviewed 97 development project plans for compliance with drainage code


2024 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Background

Sexual Violence is a widespread problem that affects people of all genders, ages, races, religions, incomes, professions, ethnicities and sexual orientations.

Founded by the Pennsylvania Coalition against Rape in 2000, the National Sexual Violence Resource Center (NSVRC) develops and disseminates resources regarding all aspects of sexual violence prevention and intervention.

2025 marks the twenty-fourth anniversary of Sexual Assault Awareness Month. This year's campaign theme is "Together We Act, United We Change", and aims to shift how communities understand, talk about, and respond to sexual abuse, assault, and harassment.



Proclamation
