Purpose and Recommendation The purpose of this agenda item is for the City Council to receive an update on passenger-only water taxi service. No action is required. Suggested Motion Motion: None. Background A passenger-only water taxi has long been considered as a project of potential value for our City. The

The continuation of the pilot project in the summer of 2023 was canceled due to mechanical problems

with the boat that had been chartered for the season. There will not be passenger-only water taxi service in the summer of 2024.

Discussion

The City retained consultant Peter Philips to help develop the original 2022 pilot, and to explore new opportunities for establishing permanent passenger-only water taxi service from the Des Moines Marina to Seattle and points south. His duties specifically included:

Water Taxi

- 1. Identify and secure funding and operational partner(s) for expanded passenger only ferry service and to ensure long-term viability of permanent seasonal and/or permanent year-round water taxi service.
- 2. Secure vessel (consistent with City Council direction), terminals and operator for permanent, regularly scheduled water taxi service to Seattle.
- 3. Explore the possibility of other marine transit routes, especially a southern route toward Tacoma.

Mr. Philips will provide the City Council with an update on his efforts and outcomes in 2024 to date.

Background

The alleyway that runs north/south through the Marina District between Marine View Drive and 7th Ave S. does not currently have a name. In recent years the City has invested in improvements to the alleyway in an effort to increase pedestrian access and activate the alleyway with retail and dining opportunities. Naming the alleyway is an additional method of raising awareness and promotion of this innovative area within the City.

The City's Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC) was tasked with collecting ideas for a name. Members gathered input from their neighbors as well as shared a survey link created by the City to facilitate idea collection. The online survey was also shared with the public via methods such as the Waterland Blog and local PTSA groups. It was agreed that no "contest" or "honor" would be promised to the individual whose name submission was selected. Instead, the entire CAC would be recognized for their collective work on this project. All naming ideas were submitted Monday, April 22, for compilation and distribution to CAC members ahead of their April 24 meeting. During the meeting, attendees voted for their top three choices, which were then consolidated into an overall top three for submission to the City Council.

Discussion

A total of 391 naming suggestions were submitted to the CAC. From this long list of suggestions, the CAC narrowed it down to a select few, with the top three recommendations to the Council being:

- Backstage Alley (10 votes)
- Jack's Alley (10 votes)
- Waterland Alley/Way (5 votes).

Volunteers from the CAC will deliver a brief presentation to the Council on the basis for their determination and the background. At that point the Council can make their final selection.

The naming of a street/alley requires an ordinance approved by the City Council. Once the Council selects the name, staff will prepare an ordinance to bring forward to effectuate the final change.

Background

In partnership with the City, Consor conducted a comprehensive assessment of the City's internal and external communications and engagement practices to learn how to better serve the evolving needs of a diverse and growing city. The City worked with the Consor team to conduct several engagement activities with key stakeholders, including City Councilmembers, City staff, and residents. The first engagement activity was to interview all City Councilmembers and key City staff. The consultant team also conducted two focus groups, one with a focus on business owners and the other on residents; conducted a community-wide survey, hosted online and printed in the City Currents Magazine; and interviewed a peer city to learn about their communications strategies and practices. Feedback and insights from all engagement activities, along with a City Council work session, informed the recommendations of their initial draft report.

Consor presented their initial draft report on March 7 to the City Council and the public during a Council Study Session. Consor walked through the process they used to develop their report and then took questions from the Council and comments from the public. Finally Consor presented their draft recommendations.

Following the Council meeting, Consor compiled comments from the Council and the public and finalized their report.

Using all the feedback collected from the various engagement methods and suggestions from Councilmembers at the study session, the consultant team made the following recommendations:

Short-Term Recommendations: Within a Year

- Increase the variety of tools and methods to share timely, accurate information about City business with community members. Implemented by City staff and the City Manager.
- Implement an accessible community feedback process, which includes a timeline for responses and staff follow-up back to the community or community member. Implemented by City staff and City Manager.
- Update the City organization chart with roles and responsibilities. Implemented by the City Manager.
- City website updates to improve navigation and user experience. Implemented by City staff.
- Provide consistent briefing-level reports and packets to all Councilmembers ahead of council meetings. Implemented by City staff and the City Manager.
- Develop more robust and consistent onboarding and training for City Councilmembers and City staff, especially around communications protocols and policies. Implemented by HR Director and City Manager.

Mid-Term Recommendations: Between one to two years

- Develop and refine community engagement guidelines, which include regular staff engagement with community members at accessible community events. Implemented by City staff and the City Manager, with support from Councilmembers.
- Begin to create a full-time communications position. Implemented by City staff, the City Manager, and Councilmembers.

Long-Term Recommendations: Longer than two years

• Develop a comprehensive, strategic communications plan to guide internal and external communications and engagement policies, practices, and strategies. Implemented by City staff and the City Manager, with support from Councilmembers.

In addition to these recommendations, staff heard from the Council regarding their priorities at the April 6 follow up study session.

Discussion

At the April 6 Study Session, staff was asked to create buckets of items based on the recommendations that could be achieved immediately, mid-term and long term based on available resources.

Since the April 6 Study Session, the City was able to reassign Nicole Nordholm to become the City's Communications Director. By devoting an employee to focus primarily on communications, this significantly accelerated the City's ability to implement the recommendations in a more efficient manner while also accomplishing one of the identified "mid-term" recommendations.

During the discussion on June 6, City staff will present to the Council items that have already been completed, items that are in progress, and also items that will need additional time and/or resources to be completed. Council will also be given the opportunity to provide feedback and assist with prioritization of outstanding items.
