

Meet Our GPS Team's Crisis Response Specialist: Monica T. Lara

T n a city that constantly evolves, ensuring the safety and well-being of our community is of utmost importance. At the forefront of this mission is Monica T. Lara, our Getting People Services (GPS) Team's Crisis Response Specialist, who plays a pivotal role in navigating complex emergency situations with calm expertise and dedication.

Navigating Through Crisis with Expertise

GPS – Getting People Services with the Des Moines Police Department.

This team focuses on taking a holistic approach to law enforcement encounters with persons experiencing behavioral health issues.

Whether responding to in-progress calls or conducting follow up, the goal of the GPS Team is to divert individuals from the traditional criminal justice system and redirect them to the most appropriate resources.

Monica Lara holds a Bachelor's degree in Psychology and a Master's degree in Psychology and Child Development. With a career spanning several years in social services, Monica's dedication to creating safer environments for communities is evident. Before relocating to Washington from New Mexico, she worked with victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.

Since joining the City of Des Moines in late 2022, Monica has played a pivotal role in supporting both the community and law enforcement officers - leveraging her expertise to assist those in need. Her passion for helping others shines through in her commitment to making a positive impact.

A Day in the Life of a Crisis Response Specialist

What does a typical day look like for Monica? While each day can present unique challenges, Monica's role generally involves



assessing potential risks, developing response strategies, and liaising with other emergency services to ensure a cohesive approach.

Her responsibilities also include supporting PD as well as community outreach to enhance preparedness and resilience. This consists of assisting patrol and the

community with 911 calls, doing

follow up with referrals from patrol, doing outreach with the unhoused community in Des Moines.

Monica's ability to make swift, informed decisions is complemented by her empathetic approach, ensuring that the human element is never lost in the midst of crisis management.

When to Call For Help:

If you or someone you know exhibits any of the following:

- Thoughts of suicide, serious depression or other mental health concerns.
- · Feelings of wanting to hurt yourself or others.
- Increased mental health symptoms making it difficult to attend work, school or family.
- · Disorganization making it difficult to seek shelter, food or attend to basic needs.

Warning Signs of a Mental Health Crisis:

A mental health crisis can display in a variety of ways. There is no one indicator that a person is experiencing a mental health emergency or may attempt suicide, but here are some signs to look for. The person may be:

- Unable to complete daily tasks like getting dressed, brushing teeth, bathing, etc.
- Verbally saying, writing or insinuating that they'd like to kill themselves and/or talking about death.
- · Withdrawing from friends, family and their typical social situations.
- Showing impulsive or reckless behavior, being aggressive.
- Having dramatic shifts in mood, sleeping or eating patterns.
- Loss of touch with reality (psychosis): unable to recognize family or friends, confuse, strange ideas, thinks they are someone they are not, doesn't understand what people are saying, hearing voices, seen things that aren't there.
- Paranoia: intense anxious or fearful feelings and thoughts often related to persecution, threat, or conspiracy.



Commute Trip Reduction 4 Plan Update **Reduction 4 Year**

n 1991, the state legislature enacted the Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Law to address growing concern for traffic congestion, air pollution, and gas dependency. The CTR law aims to encourage workers to drive alone less by riding 🗘 the bus, walking or biking, sharing the ride, or skipping it all together by teleworking or working a compressed work week. Cities and counties affected by the CTR law are required to update their CTR plans every 4 years, and outreach to CTR affected communities is part of those updates.



Middle Housing Regulations Update

lanning for Middle Housing in Des Moines is well underway in partnership with the City's Community Development Department and its consultant, AHBL! Together, we will conduct public outreach associated with integrating Middle Housing into the City's policies and regulatory structure.

What is Middle Housing?

Middle housing is defined as buildings that are compatible in scale, form, and character with single-family houses and contain two or more dwelling units. Middle housing types can include duplexes, townhouses, cottage housing and others. The purpose is to create more homes for Washington by increasing middle housing in areas traditionally dedicated to single-family detached housing.

What is the status of Middle **Housing in Des Moines?**

The initial work on the Middle Housing Grant project will run



concurrently with the comprehensive plan update. The City is currently working on the periodic review and update to our comprehensive plan that is due by December 31, 2024. The review and adoption of the development regulations to implement HB 1110 will occur between January and June 2025. City staff and AHBL created a task list for Middle Housing work that includes:

- Creating a public engagement plan
- · Preparing maps to establish land capacity for the construction of middle housing units and areas that may require additional infrastructure support
- Preparing memos to identify choices that City decision-makers can use to

evaluate options for middle housing in Des Moines


- · Preparing draft regulation amendments
- Providing assistance related to the adoption of Middle Housing regulations and comprehensive plans updates

So far, the first three tasks have been completed!

aritime High School in Des Moines launches its new **Marine Construction program** in September.

Maritime High School juniors and seniors now have three pathways to choose from: Marine Construction, Marine Science, and Vessel Operations.

Students who choose the Marine Construction program will receive hands-on shipyard training and earn a maritime shipyard welding certificate to become highly employable marine welders. Teachers, mentors and industry professionals provide a well-

rounded education plus the industry certifications necessary to jumpstart future career paths.

Marine welding students will spend part of each day at a training center located at Seattle's Harbor Island Shipyard. Bus transportation is provided.

The Harbor Island Training Center is jointly operated by Vigor Industrial Shipyards and South Seattle College. This pathway is funded through Running Start and funds raised by Northwest Maritime Center.

Maritime High School Blends Academic & Hands-on Learning

When not participating in off-campus training and learning experiences, juniors and seniors in all three pathways work with Maritime High School instructors on complementary projects, with a blend of academic and hands-on learning opportunities.
